From the 30th of June to the 7th of July, 40 young people and youth leaders from Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, the Czech Republic, and Spain will come together to explore how urban art can become a tool for social transformation. This isn't just about making art—it's about making change. Throughout the exchange, we'll dive deep into the world of graffiti, murals, installations, and performances—not just as creative expressions, but as vehicles for solidarity, inclusion, and political awareness.

Imagine walking the streets and seeing the walls around you come alive—not just with color, but with messages of hope, resistance, and community. In Sant Joan Despí, public spaces will become our canvases, and our voices will echo through them. As we create, we'll be reclaiming those spaces, challenging stereotypes, and inviting the local community to be part of something bigger than a brushstroke or a spray of paint.

This exchange is built on collaboration. Side by side with local youth and artists, you'll be shaping stories that reflect both shared and unique realities. Through meaningful conversations, artistic exploration, and cultural exchange, we'll forge connections that reach far beyond borders. You'll meet peers from different backgrounds, discover new ways of thinking, and gain skills that empower you to launch your own urban art initiatives once you return home.

Whether you've already filled walls with your artwork or you're just beginning to discover the power of your creativity, this is your opportunity to be seen, heard, and part of a movement that believes in the power of young people to spark change. Together, we'll turn ideas into actions and actions into impact—one brush, one word, one mural at a time.

So, if you're ready to connect with others, to create boldly, and to lead with heart—this is your moment. Let's make our streets speak, our voices rise, and our communities come alive through the art we create together.

YOUTH EXCHANGE

FROM the 30th June to 6th of July, 2025

(Sunday the 29th June and Monday the 7th July, 2025, as travelling days.)

It is allowed to arrive/leave the country **2-3 days** before/after the youth exchange, at your own expenses. During the program of the YE **we will NOT visit Barcelona.**

The venue for the YE will take place in the municipality of Sant Joan Despí Each country will participate with 1 LEADER (not limit age) + 5 PARTICIPANTS (18-30 y.o., being 2-3 of them with fewer opportunities).



Youth Exchange

Regarding flights, if your group decide to travel on the travel days, we would recommend you to land at **Barcelona-El Prat airport** on the **29th June before 16h** in order to get on time to the meeting point, and to have a **flight back on Monday the 7th July from 12-13h** onwards.

HOW TO GET TO THE MEETING POINT

1) From Barcelona Airport to Plaça Catalunya

The journey from the airport to Plaça Catalunya is +/- 30-45 min.

From Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, there are 3 options to get to the meeting point:


1 - AIRBUS (5,90€ one-way ticket / 10,20€ return ticket): From Barcelona-El Prat to Plaça Catalunya directly. 30 min.

This option is much comfortable and easy in our opinion (but up to you, of course).

Stop called "PLAÇA ESPANYA".

2 - TRAIN (**2,40€**): From **Barcelona- El Prat, airport** (the train is at Terminal 2, although there is a shuttle bus that connects both terminals T1<->T2) to **Sants Estació**, is **25 min**.

Train (RENFE) R2N, stop called "PASSEIG DE GRÀCIA".

From there take the L3 metro line (the green one) and stop in "LES CORTS"



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3- METRO (5,15€): From Barcelona – El Prat to Torrassa with L9S, and from Torrassa to Catalunya with L1. It takes ~50min.

Once you are in "LES CORTS" walk 10 minutes to the hostel

By metro, there is a specific ticket from/to the airport!



The working place for the YE

The **activities** of the YE will take place at the **Youth Center El Bulevard,** a reference place for youth with space for meeting, growth and empoweriment, where there are different rooms and spaces for workshops, a meeting space with a youth information point and open spaces.







Rules for the correct development of YE

- Youth Exchange leaders and participants will use a digital platform for keeping in touch, sharing photos... not to ask logistical aspects throught the group.
- Every YE leader and participant must have and bring his/her personal European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
- Every participant country group must prepare 3 energizers.
- Under working commissions, every participant country group will collaborate with dining basic tasks (preparation of the tables, sweeping the dining room, etc).
- Every country will organise one International Night, with food and drinks, quizz, dances...
- Every country group must prepare and lead a session during the YE programme.

Rules for leaders

- Every group leader must forward (send to an e-mail and tell in leader meetings) all information gathered in APV to their own group.
- Every group leader has to take care about the procedure of the documents on Erasmus+ Program (save boarding passes, train and bus tickets, etc.) in order to give them to the coordination of the project during and after the YE.
- Every group leader is directly responsible for his/her group and he/she must watch over for every participant's safety and wellbeing.
- All group leaders must be involved in all activities (supervising, giving help if needed, etc.).
- 30 minutes before dinner the group leader will participate in a 30 minutes briefing.
- After breakfast I group leader (taking turns) will lead a talk with the group of all participants to explain the daily plan.
- Every morning every leader will work with his/her own group on participants' Youth Pass.

The organisation reserves the right to expel the participant in case your choice is not to participate actively during the project

Rules for participants

- Every participant is requested to respect timetable and to be on time and ready to actively participate in every activity.
- It is mandatory to keep in order common rooms and to collaborate to keep private rooms clean. Guests will be expected to reimburse for any damage caused by inappropriate behavior during their stay.
- Smoking inside the living and working places is not allowed.
- Bringing food and eating inside the living and working places are not allowed.
- Every participant must bring his/her own towel and hygienic products. Sheets and blankets are provided.
- Every participant must respect the silence time at the hostel from 00:00 and MUST be back at the building before 1:00 a.m.
