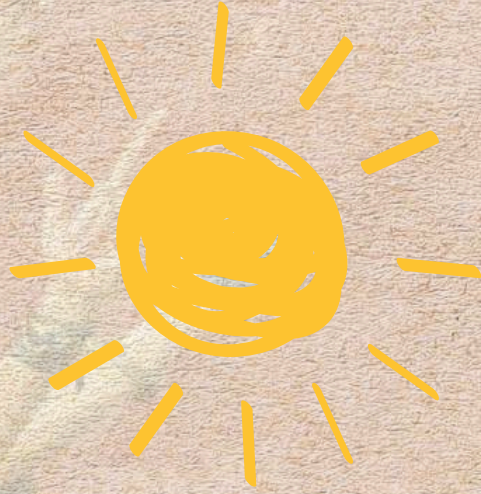

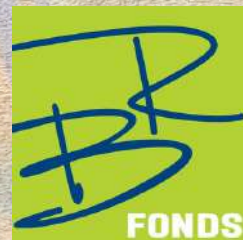

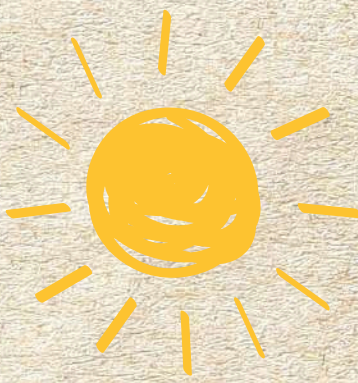

overview on the project



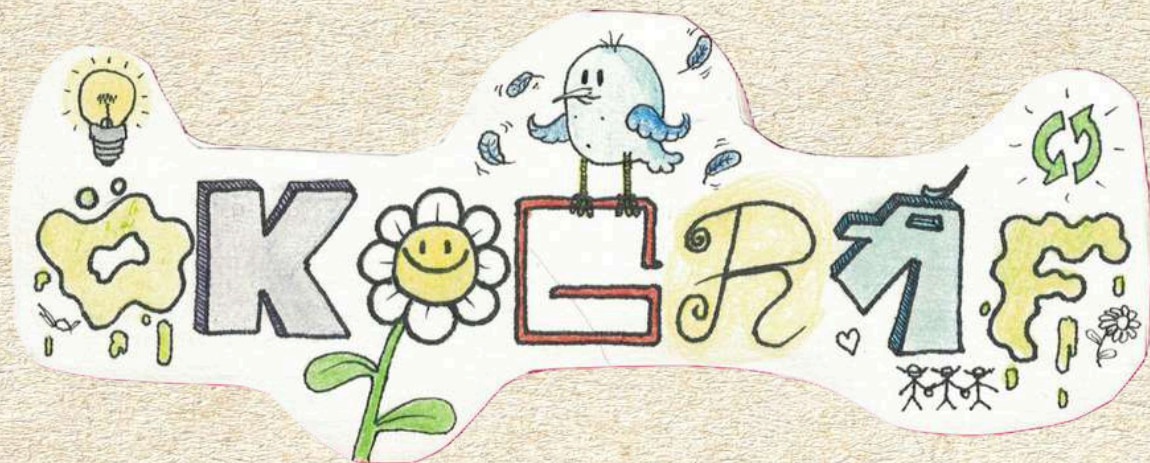
"Recycling is Cool" :

Is an intercultural program where participants learn creative recycling techniques using non-formal educational methods in order to protect the environment and reduce waste. Another goal of the program is for participants to jointly discover both European and local traditional values, while gaining an understanding of the cultural heritage related to them and their importance.

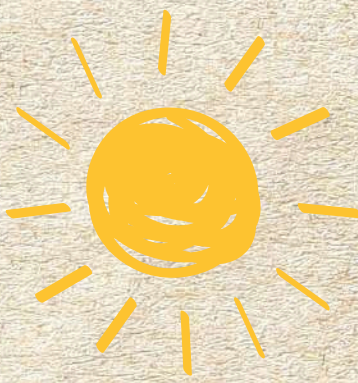
During the project, they work in five workshop under the leadership of participating local shift experts.

Participants can learn "slow" and "green" techniques and tangible activities in individual workshops that are based on tradition and meet the tastes and expectations of young people.

In addition, the project encourages the entrepreneurial activity of young people, sets a good example for the useful use of free time, independent and creative living, and provides experience and knowledge for managing similar occupations.



Details about the project :



In the course of the project, we provide the opportunity to introduce ourselves, participate in workshops, present the participants' country and values at intercultural evenings, and discover the city's values with excursions and city tours. During the trips, they get to know our local values, meet our built cultural heritage, and young people from different countries have the opportunity to meet local people. During the intercultural evenings, the participants present where they came from based on the values of their own settlement and region (pictures, videos, presentations).



Details about the project :



During the project, we consider the involvement of the local community to be of particular importance, in the evenings, for example, we invite them to join leisure programs or to conversations sitting around the campfire.



We strive to ensure that all workshop leaders are local professionals with project experience. Their work is assisted by a youth assistant and facilitator experienced in youth projects. Together with the workshop leaders, the youth assistant constructs the activities based on non-formal educational methods.

The task of the facilitator is also to help the participants become aware of the experiences and skills acquired in a non-formal (experimental pedagogy, art pedagogy, experiential learning) and informal way.

These will appear in the Youthpass document at the end of the project.

Profile of participants :



The general characteristics of our participants:

Mainly young people living in urban environments, economically disadvantaged (low-income, long-term unemployed or long-term poverty young people) 50% per group.

In order to do this, during their preparation, the organizations hold preparatory lectures and training sessions on what the basic project implementation experiences are, and analyze and resolve possible conflict situations together.

The groups consist of 4 participants (16-30 years old) per country and a main group leader over the age of 18.

Each group is characterized by young people coming from the same region and/or community.

Activities :



Will be determined by the results of team building and the presentation of the project's goals, the steps taken to achieve the results (days 1-2). – group session, face-to-face session, non-formal learning methods.

- Paper recycling workshop
- Plastic recycling workshop
- Metal and wood recycling workshop
- Textile recycling workshop
- Glass and porcelain recycling workshop



The planned activities are carried out by the participants in five smaller groups of mixed nationalities, rotating, so that we ensure that everyone can get a taste of each piece of knowledge, as well as improve working skills in mixed groups.

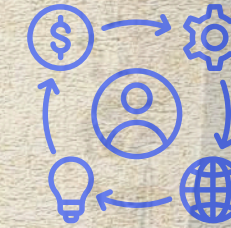

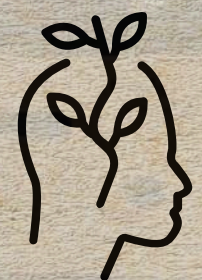


Presentation of enterprises, manufactories, and social enterprises that fit the theme of the project.

About project venue:

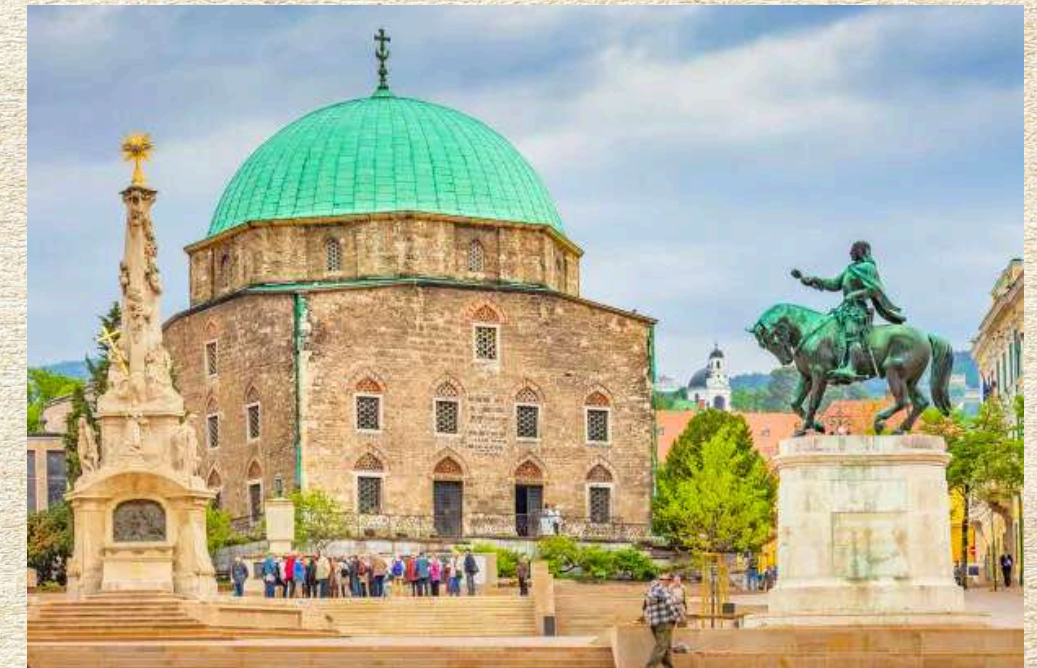
Hassagy is a small village in southwestern Hungary, in Baranya County.

It has a peaceful, rural atmosphere with lots of greenery. Even though it's a quiet place, it's only about 20 minutes by bus from Pécs—a lively city full of cafés, pubs, cultural centers, universities, malls, and a large international student community.

Our main activity venue is Hassagy, is the authentic Hungarian village which gives us creativity and peace ; we have workshops under the sun with an amazing nature , fresh air of the village.

We'll also visit the nearby village of Szederkeny and have chance to visit Pécs.

Pécs is about three hours from Budapest, making it easy to reach and a great place to explore culture and history.

Internet access, laundromat & grocery store near by

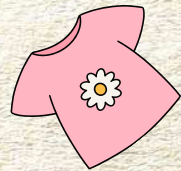

- Towels, slippers and hygienic products (shampoo, shower gel...) This can be bought in Pécs too.



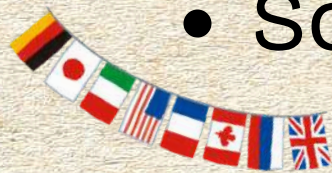
- Weather can change in Pécs so make sure to bring some warm clothes too.

About the travel:



From BUDAPEST AIRPORT to CENTER

100E – a direct bus line (shuttle bus) connecting the airport from the Terminal 2 and Deak Ferenc Square in the city center. You can buy the tickets from ticket machines outside of the airport by cash and card.

From center: “Deak Ferenc Square” to train station you can use Metro lines.
For public buses or metro you can use ticket machines.

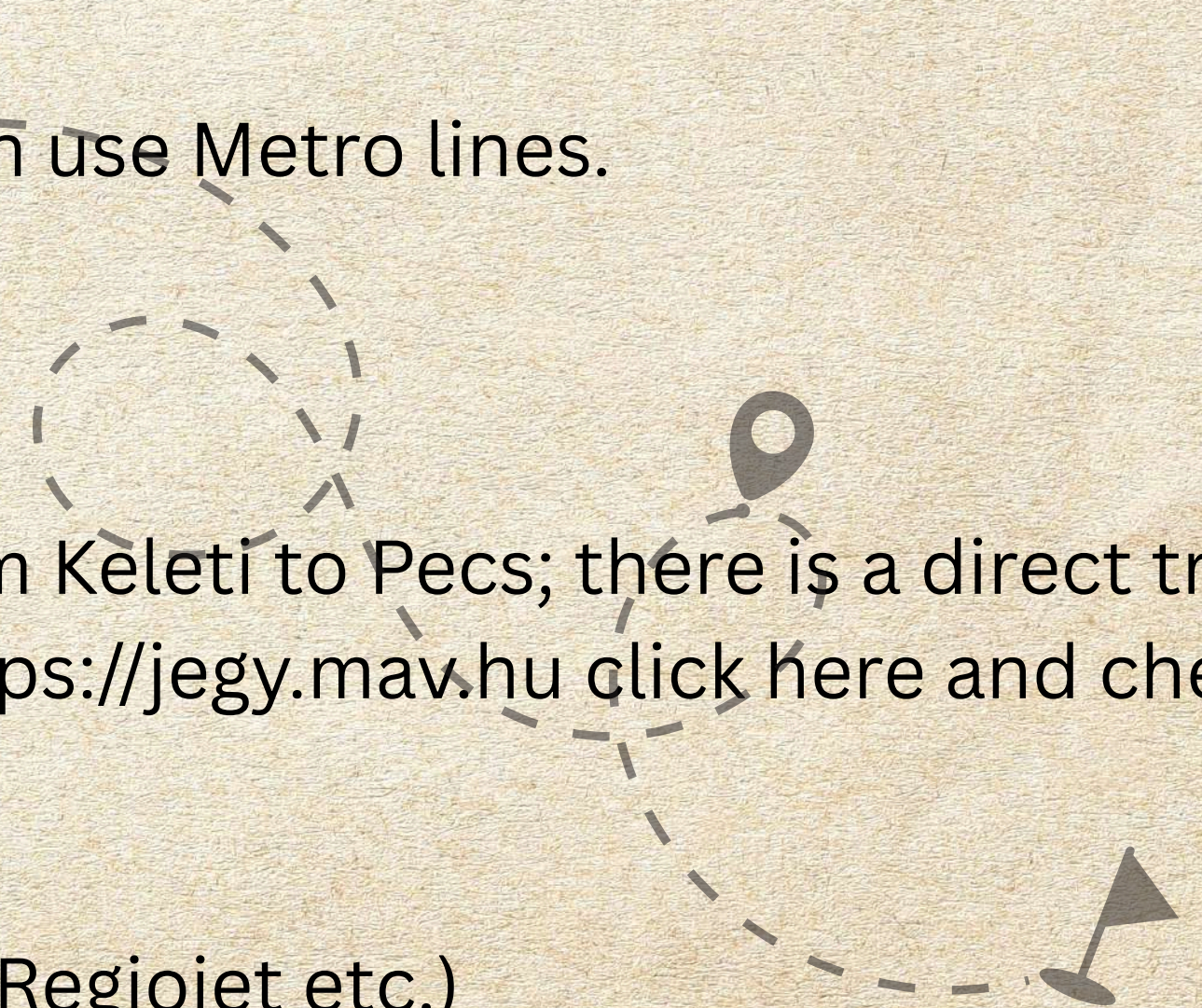
From BUDAPEST TRAIN STATION to PECS

"KELETI" is one of the main train stations in Budapest. From Keleti to Pecs; there is a direct train. You can buy train tickets online and ask for the invoice. <https://jegy.mav.hu> click here and check the tickets.

If you reach Budapest by Bus:

There are several buses to Budapest like (FlixBus, InfoBus, Regiojet etc.) KELENFÖLD is the main bus station and also another main train station. If you arrive there you can also take train from Kelenföld directly to Pecs.

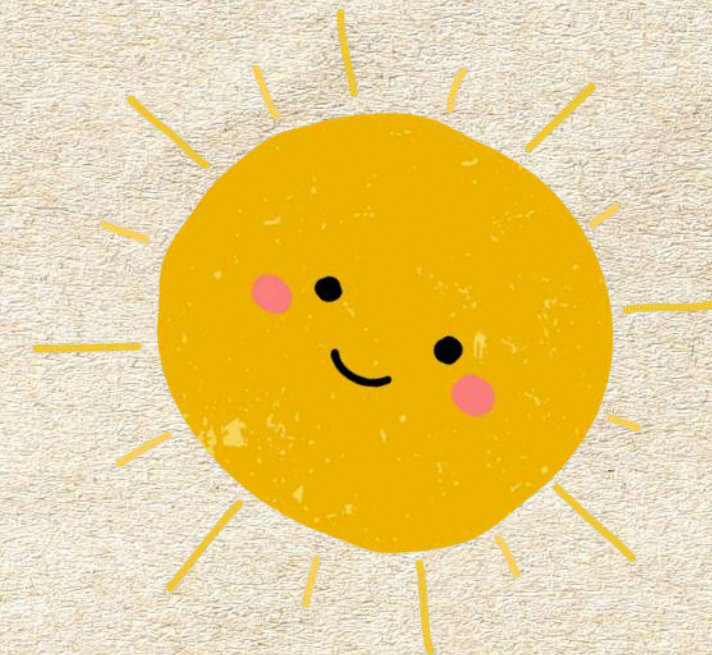
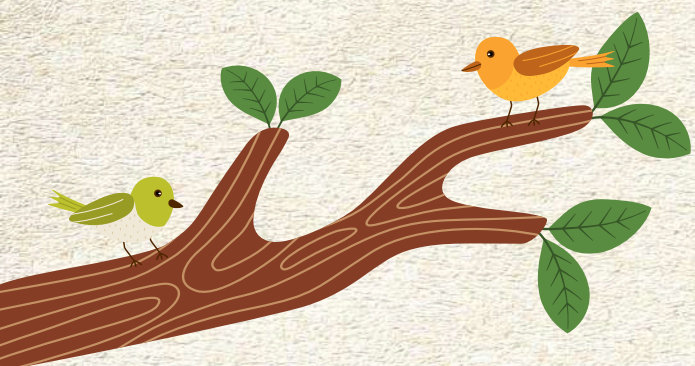
